She often arrived to the cafeteria before day break and put in many long hours ensuring that the students served from that cafeteria (not just SHS but some of the other schools in that zone as well) had hot, delicious, filling food to get them through their school day. She believed that they could not do their best if they were hungry. Mrs. Coble managed a team of ladies who worked efficiently, effectively, and excelled at providing the utmost customer service - whether it were students, faculty, staff, administration, visitors, or even the Governor himself visiting her cafeteria on any given day. She was a good steward of the county's and state's resources, leveraging what she was provided and what she had to purchase to get the best for her people and from her people. And she kept a wary eye on maintaining healthy menus that would best serve the students and staff. Outside of SHS, legend has it that Mrs. Coble, accompanied by her friend and neighbor Mrs. Betty Isley, dropped by for an impromptu visit with the then Governor, the Honorable Mr. Robert Scott, at his homeplace here in Alamance County (not too far from the site of the new high school, in fact) when petitions needed signatures for local roads to be paved in the southern part of the county - for safer driving among students and county residents. And the Honorable Governor Scott made a point to stop in at the SHS Cafeteria for visits afterward when he was in the county and had some spare time. Mrs. Coble was an activist, and enthusiast for the betterment of Alamance County, before it was even cool. Mrs. Coble's family have graced the halls of ABSS schools for generations. Her husband, Gray Coble, graduated from Alexander Wilson (where his own mother, Edna Coble, worked in the cafeteria to supplement the family's farm income), her children, Ronnie and Larry Coble, are both graduates of Southern Alamance High School, and were both school photographers in their time; two of her grandchildren, Jessica Coble Hill and Erica Coble Finchum, are graduates of SHS as well and both were proud members of the Belles and Sons, and now (4th generation) two of her great-grandchildren are enrolled at ABEC and SMS, respectively. Mrs. Coble handled everything in her life with great care and absolute class. She worked hard everyday and instilled that in her children - and this was an expectation she held for others as well. She believed in making the world around her a better place, and loved those in her sphere of influence fiercely (though often quietly) but with a resolve that was unshakable. She represents the best of the now Alamance-Burlington School System and she would be an optimal choice for namesake of the new high school.

Wyatt Outlaw High School	Naming the new high school after Wyatt Outlaw would be a significant step in the direction of righting persistent historical harm, in that it centers the story of an African-American leader in Alamance County. Like that of many people of color, his legacy has been ignored. As a community leader in Graham, Mr. Outlaw served as a town commissioner and constable. He was an entrepreneur (woodworking and cabinet making). Moreover, he was among the trustees who deeded land for Wayman Chapel AME Church. Most egregiously, his murder in February of 1870 by members of the White Brotherhood was never successfully prosecuted. Naming the high school after him would help center his role in our county's history and provide a touchstone to a story too long neglected and untold. [14]						
Wyatt Outlaw High School	Wyatt Outlaw was one of the most pivotal characters in the history of our county. His legacy has been ignored and deliberately obscured after he was lynched in Court Square in Graham. The camp of the "White Brotherhood" that carried out the lynching was based in Hawfields. Why not honor this injustice with a school that will always cause you to remember that hatred was once, and maybe still is, in our backyards.						
Wyatt Outlaw High School	As an elected official and political leader of blacks and whites after the Civil War, Wyatt Outlaw led the organization of the first schools for African Americans in Alamance Country. That fact alone would deserve the naming of a school for him.						
Hawfields High School	Further, his murder by local Klansmen in 1870 long obscured knowledge of his personal history and character. By 2000, scrupulous research in the records of the post-Civil War years uncovered and documented Outlaw's story; he was assertive, successful, and pointedly non-violent, with nothing to bar him from the public respect that naming a high school would bring.						
Wyatt Outlaw High School	Because I think this Should Have Been Built when Hawfields middle was back in the late 90's						
Bowman-Maynard High school	Mr. Outlaw helped start two schools during the Reconstruction period following the Civil War. He was an upstanding citizen who was elected to serve in Graham.
